I am a duly qualified specialist in physical medicine and rehabilitation and licensed to practice medicine by the College of Physicians and Surgeons in Ontario. I have a fellowship from the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Canada. I am a consultant physiatrist at Toronto Rehabilitation Institute, a specialist in neurological rehabilitation, musculoskeletal rehabilitation and electromyography. My clinical work involves the assessment and treatment of patients with various neurological and musculoskeletal injuries from the initial inpatient rehabilitation stay. I have an academic appointment at the University of Toronto as a lecturer and routinely teach medical students and residents. I have successfully obtained certification and proficiency in electromyography from the Canadian Congress of Neurological Sciences. I have completed a certification course in rating catastrophic impairment based on the 4th Edition AMA Guides on Permanent Impairment.
